LA CONJUGAISON DE TO LIKE EN ANGLAIS

PRESENT SIMPLE

- *I like*
- *You like*
- *He/she/it likes*
- *You like*
- *We like*
- *They like*

PRESENT CONTINUOUS

- *I am liking*
- *You are liking*
- *He/she/it is liking*
- *You are liking*
- *We are liking*
- *They are liking*

PAST SIMPLE

- *I liked*
- *You liked*
- *He/she/it liked*
- *You liked*
- *We liked*
- *They liked*

PRESENT PERFECT

- *I have liked*
- *You have liked*
- *He/she/it has liked*
- *You have liked*
- *We have liked*
- *They have liked*

PAST PERFECT

- *I had liked*
- *You had liked*
- *He/she/it had liked*
- *You had liked*
- *We had liked*
- *They had liked*

FUTURE

- *I will like*
- *You will like*
- *He/she/it will like*
- *You will like*
- *We will like*
- *They will like*

LES SYNONYMES DE TO LIKE EN ANGLAIS



- ➔ *to admire* = admirer
- ➔ *to adore* = adorer
- ➔ *to appreciate* = apprécier
- ➔ *to dig* = kiffer (familier)
- ➔ *to fancy* = avoir envie de faire quelque chose (familier)
- ➔ *to love* = aimer
- ➔ *to prefer* = préférer

LES EXPRESSIONS AVEC LE MOT LIKE



- ➔ *eat like a bird* = avoir un appétit de moineau
- ➔ *fit like a glove* = aller comme un gant
- ➔ *like a fish out of water* = pas dans son élément
- ➔ *like clockwork* = ça ne rate jamais (familier)
- ➔ *spread like wildfire* = se répandre comme une traînée de poudre
